BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT

Meets on the fourth Wednesday of each month at 6:30 p.m. and hears variance requests to the City Code of Ordinances. (A Financial Disclosure Form is required for members of this board.)

Meeting location: Council Chambers, 100 State Street West

CODE ENFORCEMENT BOARD

Meets on the first Thursday of each month at 4:00 p.m. and hears cases of alleged City Code of Ordinances violations. (A Financial Disclosure Form is required for members of this board.)

Meeting location: Council Chambers, 100 State Street West

FIREFIGHTER PENSION BOARD

Meets quarterly.

LEISURE SERVICES ADVISORY BOARD

VETERAN'S MEMORIAL ADVISORY BOARD

Meets at least twice a year, before Memorial Day and before Veterans Day, on the fourth Monday of the month at 4:00 p.m. and makes recommendations to the City Council on the criteria for name placement on the Veteran's Memorial Wall, on any special exception requests or any issues relating to Veteran's Memorial Park. ORDINANCE REVIEW COMMITTEE

Meets when called upon by the City Council and makes recommendations to the City Council concerning the City Code of Ordinances.

CHARTER REVIEW COMMITTEE

Meets when called upon by the City Council and makes recommendations to the City Council concerning the City Charter.
